



Magn Chef Competition (The Grand Trunk Food Trail)



29th January 2024 Time: 10:00 am – 12:00 pm (Reporting time 9:00 am.)

The Theme for Magn 2K23 is Kaarwaan - The Grand Trunk Odyssey... We will be tapping the States that The Grand Trunk Road passes through such as West Bengal, Jharkhand, Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, New Delhi, Haryana, Chandigarh & Punjab.

Budding Chefs are to create

- 1. Main Course with one accompaniment (One Portion)
- 2. Dessert (One Portion)

Participants may choose different States for each course and accompaniment OR A Thematic Display depicting any one State along the stretch of "The Grand Trunk Road".

<u>Cultural Storytelling</u>: Participants should present their dishes with stories or anecdotes that emphasize, the cultural and historical significance of the Grand Trunk Road.

Magn Chef Competition (The Grand Trunk Food Trail)

- Each College is allowed one entry of two participants.
- Participants are required to bring their ingredients.
- Gravies, Sauces, Pastes and Marination may be prepared in advance.
- Competition time 2 hours including plating.
- Participants are to bring their equipment, tools, cutlery, and crockery for the presentation.
- The presentation of food should be strictly traditional depicting the State/States / Delicacies/Cuisine, etc.
- Strict Grooming Standards to be followed.



Mocktail Competition (Rasmaiy!)

- Solo event Maximum 2 entries per college
- Contestant must make only 1 portion for tasting and presentation.
- We will provide basic Ingredients, Equipment, and Glasses.
- Contestant can bring their exclusive Ingredients and Equipment with prior permission.
- There will be a Master class & Preliminary round before the final round.

Flair-tending Competition (Handle with swag)

- Open for Hospitality & Bar-tending Institutes only.
- Solo event Maximum 2 entries per College/ Academy
- Participants must showcase their Flair & Bartending skills and make 1 drink using the ingredients & equipment provided in 150 seconds flat.
- Fire Flair a strict NO. Glass bottles Fine as long as you don't break them.
- Basic Bar Equipment & Flair bottles should be good enough for Flair.
- There may be an elimination round depending on the number of entries. There will be a Master class and Preliminary round, before the final round.



Table setup (Mehmaan Nawaazi)

- 1 team per college, comprising 2 members.
- Each team must set up the table with covers according to the theme. Theme briefing will be provided before the event.
- Participants can either use the equipment provided by us or bring their own (e.g., tablecloth, cutlery, crockery, glassware, etc.)
- Teams must bring their decor material and props based on the theme.
- Time limit: 2 hours.



Flower Arrangement (Phoolon ke Rang Se...)

- 1 team per college (Team comprising 2 members).
- Flowers, vases, and required materials should be brought by the participants.
- Time limit 30 minutes

Linen Origami (Creative Crafters)

- 1 team per college. (Team comprising 2 members).
- Participants are to bring their own bathroom linen & accessories.
- A maximum number of unique folds to be made in the stipulated time, the theme will be disclosed at the cultural meet.





- 1 team per college, comprising 2 members.
- Pre-preparation of any article will result in disqualification.
- Participants must bring their own necessary stationery kit.
- Participants should use their creativity to make one article or decorative piece within the given time. (1 Hour)
- The art work (Antique) should be according to the theme of the Event
- Theme: Kaarwaan (The Grand Trunk Odyssey)

Ethnic Parade (Sitaron ka kaarwan!!!)

- 1 entry per college (8-12 participants)
- Theme: Kaarwan (The Grand Trunk Odyssey)
- Performance time: 5-7 minutes.
- Participating team must submit their music track on a pen drive at the registration desk 2 hours prior to the event. <u>Music Track on mobile phones will not be accepted</u>.
- Costumes should be decent and below knee length (no tube tops, single strip tops, or backless)
- No vulgarity or stunts allowed
- Judging criteria: Concept, Costumes, Synchronization, Space utilization, Magn Factor.



Group Dance (Kismein kitna hai dum...)

- 1 entry per college (5-8 participants)
- Performance time maximum 5-6 minutes
- Participating team must submit their music track on a pen drive at the registration desk 2 hours prior to the event. <u>Music Track on mobile phones will not be accepted</u>.
- The dance form and costumes should be appropriate and decent.
- The use of idols and projection of deities is not allowed.
- Any kind of stunts will result in disqualification.
- Theme: Kaarwaan (The Grand Trunk Odyssey)
- Songs must be approved by the cultural team in advance.

Solo Singing (Raag Ratan)

- Maximum 2 entries per college.
- Time limit: 4 minutes
- Contestants are required to bring their own (-one) audio track/karaoke on a pen drive. <u>Music Track on mobile phones will not be accepted</u>.
- The dance form and costumes should be appropriate and decent.
- Pen Drive should be submitted 2 hours prior to Registration Desk.

 For Preliminary round contestant will have to sing the same song that they will be singing in the final round.

No slang or vulgar songs will be entertained.

Antakshari (Mile Sur Mera Tumhara)

- 1 team per college (team comprising 2 members)
- Rules, regulations & rounds will be given on the spot.
- Usage of electrical device is not allowed

Rangoli (Rango ki Toli)

- 1 entry per college (Theme: Unity in Diversity)
- Participants can use various materials viz. rangoli powder, flowers, color sand, glitter, etc... for creating their Masterpiece.
- No deity/religious scriptures to be portrayed
- Each participant will be given equal space for Rangoli (4'x4'ft)
- Time: 1hr 30mins
- Any kind of vulgarity will lead to disqualification.

Photography (Tasveeron Ki Zubani)

- Maximum 2 entries per college
- Theme- to be declared during briefing.
- Time limit: 2 hours after the briefing.
- Contestants should submit a maximum 10 freshly clicked best photographs of their choice to sum it up into a story.

Make-over-Before and After.

- Maximum 2 entries per college (1 artist + 1 model)
- Contestants would have to bring their material.
- Time limit: 2 hours
- Costume should be according to the theme and decent, or else would be disqualified.
- Judging criteria: concept, costumes, precise makeup look.
- Theme: Kaarwaan (The Grand Trunk Odyssey)

Mehendi (Khushrang Henna)

- Maximum 2 entries per college (1 artist + 1 handmodel)
- Contestants would have to bring their material.
- Time limit: 1 hour



Kabaddi - Le Panga!!!

- 1 team per college (comprising 7 players and 3 substitutes).
- The maximum number of teams allowed is 16. Registration will be on a first-come basis.
- The match will be played for 14 minutes, with seven minutes in each half.
- The team should report to their respective ground 15 minutes before the match.
- The referee's decision will be final.
- Event only for BOYS
- The management will not be responsible for any kind of injury.

Chess-Pins & Forks

- 1entry per college.
- 10 minutes FIDE rules apply.

Call of Duty (Yalgaar Ho...)

- 1 entry per college (Solo)
- Participant will have to carry their smart phone.
- Rules are subject to change.
- Only version 1.0.41 will be allowed.
- Ear-phones are compulsory.

Carrom Doubles (The Right Strikes)

- 1 team per college with 2 members.
- Preliminary round: single-board match.
- Finals: Best of 3 rounds.
- Participants to bring their own strikers.
- Participants to report one hour prior to the event.





Rink Football (Dhan Dhana Dhan Goal)

- 1 team per college (comprising 5 players and 3 substitutes).
- Each match will be played for 10 minutes.
- Teams should report to their respective grounds 10 minutes before the match.
- The referee's decision will be final.
- Event only for BOYS
- Management will not be held responsible for any injuries.

Box Cricket (De Ghuma Ke)

- 1 team per college (comprising 7 players and 1 substitute).
 - Participants should bring their cricket kit.
- Tennis balls will be provided.
- Management will not be responsible for any kind of injury.
- Event only for BOYS
 - The umpire's decision will be the final decision

Guidelines for visitors

We expect you to follow the below-mentioned guidelines to help us carry on MAGN smoothly. Visitors will only be permitted to enter the College premises on display of a valid Identity card. Please do not carry sharp objects, inflammable items & any other object that can be used as a weapon. Any sort of profanity or obscenity in any form will lead to disqualification & possible expulsion. Any misbehavior on the part of the participants & visitors will lead to expulsion from the premises and will reflect on their college. Anything that can be perceived as offensive to any national/religious sentiment will lead to immediate disqualification. Any changes in schedule due to unavoidable circumstances will be at the sole discretion of the organizers & will be intimated.

- Drugs, pipes, smoking paper, intoxicants, condoms
- Cigarettes, lighter, match-boxes, candles.
- Any pointed or sharp object knives, pen knives etc.

Guidelines for participants:


- Entry fee:
